Bruce to Milton Project Construction Activities

December 15, 2011

Dear Residents,

Hydro One would like to inform you about some upcoming construction activities associated with our Bruce to Milton Transmission Reinforcement Project.

Over the next several weeks Hydro One will be installing conductor (wire) on our transmission facilities inside the Hydro One Switching Station at Bruce Power. In order to fuse these wires together, we will be using implosive devices. This process makes a loud banging sound similar to that of a firearm discharging, so please do not be alarmed.

These activities will continue until Friday, December 23 and will resume again at the end of January, 2012. We expect this implosive work will continue periodically until March, 2012. Crews will be working Monday to Saturday, 7 a.m. to 4 p.m and we expect several implosive connections will be made each day.

Hydro One will be notifying residents and businesses within one kilometre of the work area. In addition, we will be notifying local police, ambulance and fire departments to ensure they are aware of the work.

We apologize in advance for the noise and any inconvenience this work may cause. We thank you for your patience while Hydro One completes this critical 500 kV transmission line that will add over 3000 megawatts of transmission capability to Ontario's grid.
